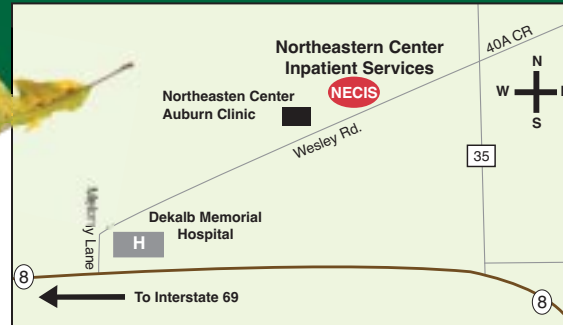
The Center maintains written policies and procedures, and a statement of consumers rights and responsibilities describes those rights and the means by which these rights are protected and exercised.

INPATIENT PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES

Inpatient Services are an important step in the complete continuum of care for people who need mental health services.

Northeastern Center's Inpatient Unit now serves adults, including geriatric adults, in the Northeastern counties of Indiana and surrounding areas. NEC Inpatient Services have been expanded to offer care to 16 adults, with an added emphasis on geriatric care. As the population of Indiana ages, NEC has taken steps to ensure that safe and effective care will be available to older adults in crisis. Our state-of-the-art facility is handicapped accessible, and features multiple "swing" doors that allow the hospital to be configured for the maximum safety of geriatric patients. The staffing ratio is 1:4 during waking hours, with additional staff available as needed for the geriatric client.

Inpatient Services are staffed with RNs, LPNs, Social Workers, and Mental Health Technicians under the direction of a Psychiatrist and Director of Nursing Services. Working together, this team of Inpatient staff is dedicated to providing a safe, therapeutic environment where people in crisis can begin to work toward emotional and behavioral stability.

Adults 18 and older can be referred through NEC's county Outpatient Offices, NEC's Geriatric Outreach Services, or after hours through NEC's Emergency Services at 800-790-0118.

Referrals are accepted from area Nursing Homes, Assisted Living Facilities, Social Service Organizations, Correction Facilities, private physicians, and professionals and families in the area.

ADMISSION TO NEC'S INPATIENT UNIT INCLUDES

- Nursing Assessment and Immediate Safety Plan
- Physical Examination
- Psychiatric Evaluation
- Discharge Needs Assessment

Immediately following Assessment, the patient and Treatment Team participate in the development of an Individual Treatment Plan and Discharge Plan.

These plans identify the objectives to be achieved and services to be provided.

Medication Management is provided by the Attending Psychiatrist and the nursing staff. Nursing staff instruct the patient in the purpose of the medication, how to take the medication properly, the intended benefits of the medication, and any possible side effects.

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
